Whether you have road access, or boat access only, or if you have a private / shared dock or retained foreshore below the highwater mark and fall within the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA) jurisdiction, you are affected by the new amended foreshore licenses being issued by the VFPA. If you do not have a license, you could be even more at risk of a demand for immediate removal of your dock and parcel A by the VFPA.

These are egregious new terms and will impact the enjoyment of your waterfront property and ultimately the monetary value of your property by way of constructive expropriation.
