### **Your Waterfront License with Vancouver Fraser Port Authority**

Following our first Notice on Monday June 5, we wanted to give you an update on our progress. Our email campaign to senior executive Jennifer Natland, Acting VP Real Estate, produced immediate results with mention of the residential licenses at the Board meeting and responses to individual licensees.

We have made a lot of progress in reaching out to waterfront residential licensees in other jurisdictions including all of Indian Arm and contacts in West Vancouver. We have also obtained more information on licenses held in these areas for comparison to ours.

A formal request to the Port for a meeting with our Committee and representatives of the other areas impacted has been requested and we will report back the results after we have met.

We will continue on our action plan that we previously outlined:

- Collect input from our neighbors
- Contact other jurisdictions
- Seek political support to put pressure on the Port to resolve our concerns
- Explore the option to purchase parcel A of the license – reclaimed area
